Are We Making Progress?

And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. (Genesis 2:16-17)



It would seem almost ludicrous to ask the question: Has mankind made progress since his appearance on this planet? Many would answer that it should be perfectly obvious that man has come a long way from primitive beginnings in the cave. Until recently, historians have always spoken of the idea of progress in history but this is now being seriously questioned. While it is true that there have been improvements and innovations in technology throughout human history, each step forward has brought with it a mixed blessing. For example, the invention of the movable-type printing press reduced the cost of printing, thus making Bibles much more readily available. While the Bible helped establish moral absolutes, printing presses also produced pornography and politically dangerous ideas. More recently, television seemed like free entertainment, but overindulgence has robbed many of their health and the ability to think for themselves.

In the very first chapters of the Bible, we are told how, in disobedience to God's command, our first parents, Adam and Eve, ate the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. It is mankind's fallen nature that has caused the good and the evil to come together as a package. We have made progress in technology, but we have also regressed morally. As it was in the days of Noah, the earth has become filled with war and violence by man's use of good inventions put to evil purpose.

Pastor Lloyd- As he meets with many groups to make the relocation of the church and the community possible.

For Us- :I tried to book return tickets only to find that the airlines are only offering business class at \$3500 US a ticket. This will delay our return. We are praying that more tickets will come available.

Background Info: Our church consists of informal settlers. An informal settler is a person who lives on land that does not belong to them. They usually live along rivers, under bridges, and on property where the owner has left it empty. They do this in hopes of finding a better life for themselves and their families. They are drawn by a dream of a better job, schooling, medicine and life.

Unfortunately they end up being hated by their neighbours as nuisance and criminals. This is the case of the people we serve. They are no longer wanted in their subdivisions and the homeowners want them out. They have fenced them in, do not allow them to take public transportation or use their scooters to go home but make them walk 2 miles from the nearest public transportation stop. They cannot prevent them from going home but they can make them walk a long distance to make it difficult. It has contributed to the death of two elderly residents who could not get to a hospital in time. One had heart failure and another had an asthmatic attack. It has been a difficult situation for the past three years but it worsened during the pandemic when the subdivision made life harder during a time when many of the informal settlers had lost their jobs.
